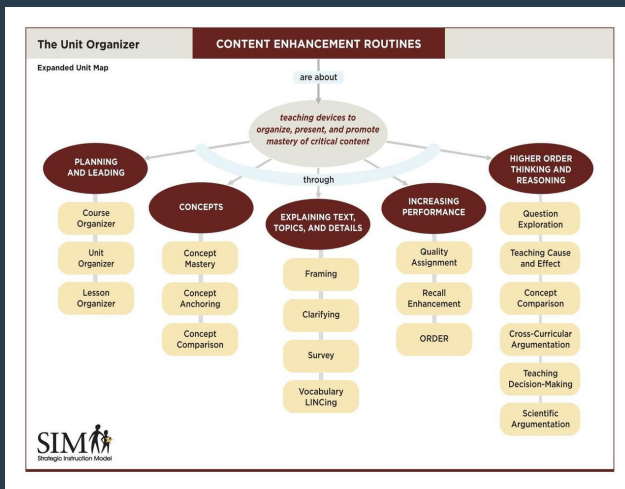

SIM Research News - iSTAR: An Integrated Strategic Technology-based Adaptive wRiting Program

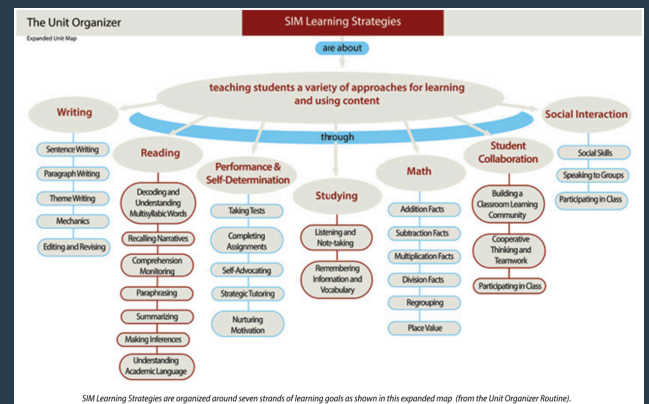


KU CRL researchers are currently working on iStar, a digital platform to support teachers implementing some of the Strategic Instruction Model (SIM™) Strategies (the *Proficiency in Sentence Writing Strategy* and the *Paragraph Writing Strategy*). iSTAR will integrate artificial intelligence (AI) into an existing technology-based writing program designed for adolescents with disabilities. As part of the SIM mission to improve outcomes for adolescents with disabilities, iSTAR will provide students, their teachers, and their families equitable web-based access to engaging, evidence-based writing instructional support that provides quick, ongoing feedback and adapts based on the student's learning needs, preferences, interests, and contexts.



SIM Content Enhancement Routines (CER)
Dynamic instructional tools that using teaching devices and procedures to plan for and teach critical content in an understandable, easy-to-learn manner. Teachers engage students collaboratively to develop understanding to maintain the integrity of the content while meeting both group and individual needs.

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SIM Learning Strategies (LS)
Students use SIM Learning Strategies to help them understand information and solve problems. SIM learning Strategy instruction focuses on making students active learners.
